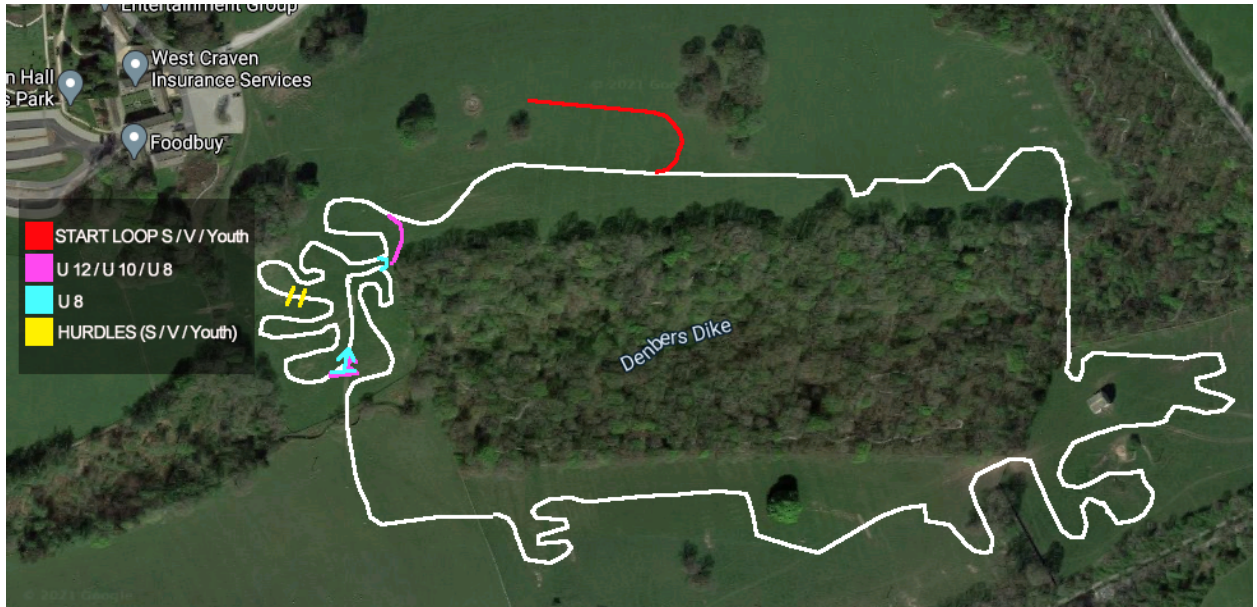
Each round will have 'main clubs' from the North West region who will help promote and staff the events, but Dave Haygarth is 'fronting' this series of races as the organiser.

Event summary for riders

A series of races - **part of the 2020-21 NWCCA league** held on private land and under the British Cycling COVID-19 guidance, and under the rules of the North Western Cyclo-cross Association rules and code of conduct.

Each event will be run with a **different "host" club** providing most of the logistical and organisational backup, but at the same safe, secure venue.

There will be an arm number (to be worn on the left sleeve) and a back number for each rider. **Riders are requested to bring 8 safety pins for their numbers.**

This is held under **British Cycling Rules as a non ranking event** - there are no National Ranking Points available in the current season.

Online entry only. Fields will be limited at the time of selection based on the prevailing British Cycling guidance at that time on field sizes.

There are no pits, and no jet washers or air compressors are permitted on site, and no outside assistance by parents or guardians for any riders, including our younger riders.

There is to be no bike, shoe or rider cleaning whatsoever in the event car parks. Bucket and brush can be used to clean your equipment but we must keep the car parks free from mud, to allow us to use this venue in the future.

Full compliance with the current social distancing measures are an absolute requirement. Riders or their parents / guardians who are in violation of this will be prevented from entering further events

There will be no spectators, and riders watching other events must only be there for safeguarding purposes, such as parents or guardians. You will be expected to turn up no more than 1 hour before your event and leave within 30 minutes of its finish unless you are with a family member from your household who is riding in a different event to yours.

Coronavirus - reminder for safety at cycle racing events



Self-assess

Don't leave the house if you have any Covid-19 symptoms, and follow NHS Test and Trace procedures.



No spitting

Please don't spit, and if you need to cough or sneeze please do so in a tissue or the crook of your elbow. Always throw used tissues in a bin. Dispose of your tissue as soon as possible.



Read the guidance

The event environment will be different to what you're used to, so read the relevant guidance from British Cycling and the event organiser.



Listen to officials and volunteers

Make sure you're present and attentive during any briefings, and follow any on-site instructions. If something doesn't look right, report it.



Keep your hands clean

Wash and sanitise your hands regularly. Some sanitiser may be provided, but bring your own just in case.



No shouting

Evidence suggests that shouting increases the risk of transmission, so please communicate calmly.



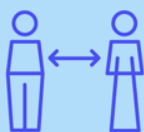
Be self-sufficient

Bring your own equipment and refreshments, as usual hire and catering facilities may be unavailable.



Say thanks

We couldn't enjoy racing without the support of our event organisers, officials and volunteers – so say thanks!



Maintain social distancing

Make sure you keep at least two metres from others before and after your race – particularly in busy waiting areas.



Have fun

With no ranking points at stake, enjoy the race and have fun!

Timetable of events

Riders should be at the start / gridding area between 10 and 5 minutes before their event. Note that the course familiarisation opportunities are VERY limited and short - there is a lot to pack into the day.

Practice on the course

Competitors must not ride on the course at all apart from on the event date.

There are very limited opportunities for course familiarisation, because the event is taking place with several races in one single day, with limited daylight.

Riders on the course outside of the times shown above will be subject to immediate disqualification from their event. For the purpose of clarity:

- Riders must NOT BE at any time that a competitor is still racing in an event, as the timetable may have 'slipped'.
- Course sighting Must be ridden as a solo rider, and strictly observing the prevailing social distancing guidelines with other riders practicing
- Must be continuous, and keeping a forward motion (i.e. not turning back to 'session' parts of the course).

Start, Finish and gridding area

Riders should prepare in the grid not earlier than 10 minutes before their race start.

They must observe social distancing guidelines when entering the gridding area before their race

IMPORTANT!

- **You should bring your own NWCCA ankle timing chip if you own one.**
- **Bring your own number pins (8) if possible - we have some in a container of Isopropyl to keep you safe, if you need them**

There should be no congregating after the race and riders should proceed through the taped off exit area after racing - leaving timing chips (if they do not own their NWCCA timing chip) in the bucket provided

Disposable numbers will be used in this series.

The grid will be 10 riders wide and the rider numbers will be used to grid them. The grid boxes will NOT be marked with numbers, and riders will be called to the grid BY THEIR NUMBER in blocks of ten. They can choose their place in priority number order. This is to prevent 'gaps' in the grid for any riders not turning up.

At the race finish, or upon the withdrawal of a competitor, exit must be made through the taped area, and timing chips must be placed in the bucket provided, unless the competitor owns their NWCCA chip

No congregation of riders is permitted either before or after the race

Traffic and parking

NOTE that this is a change from the previous events in 2020

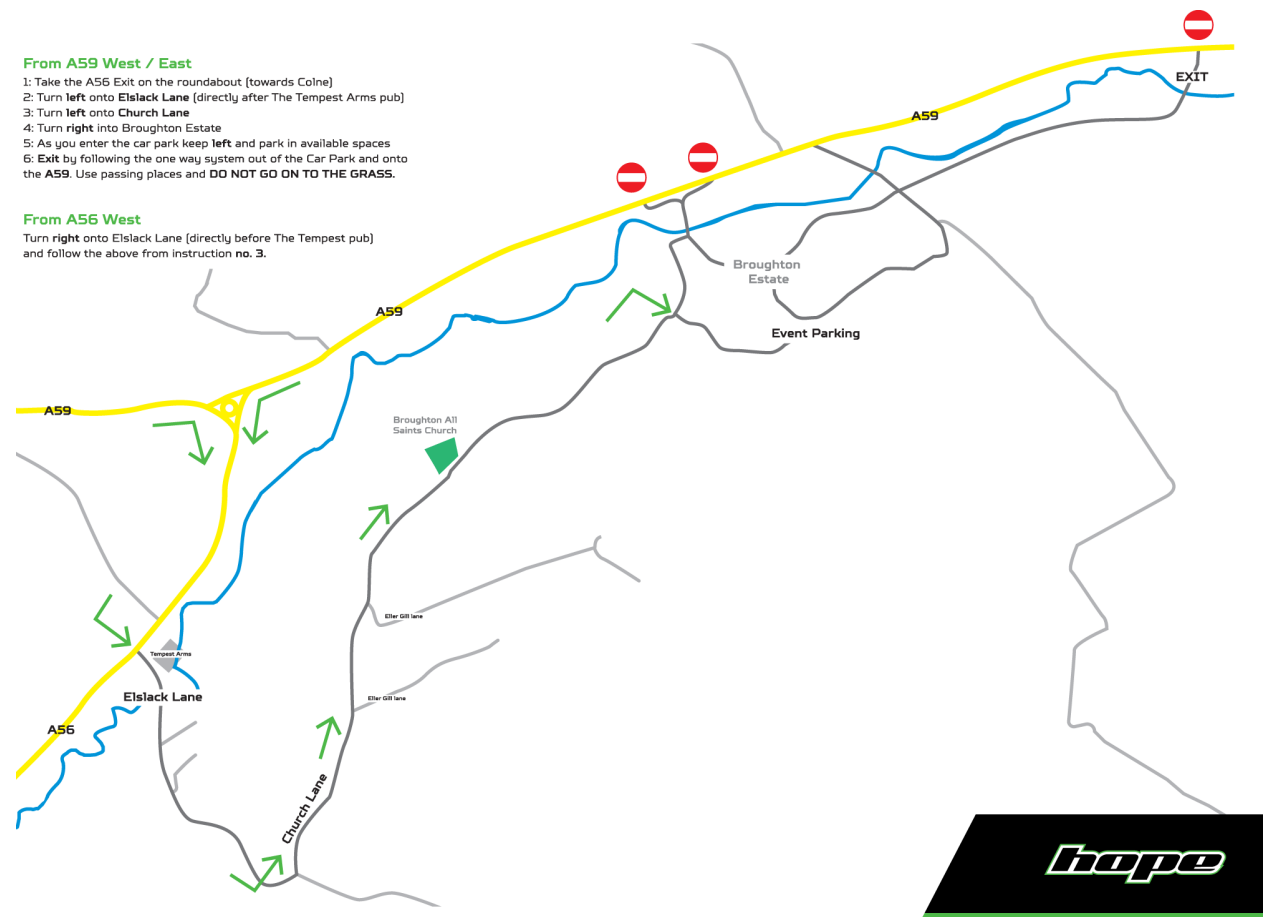
The bridge has been deemed unsafe for vehicles.

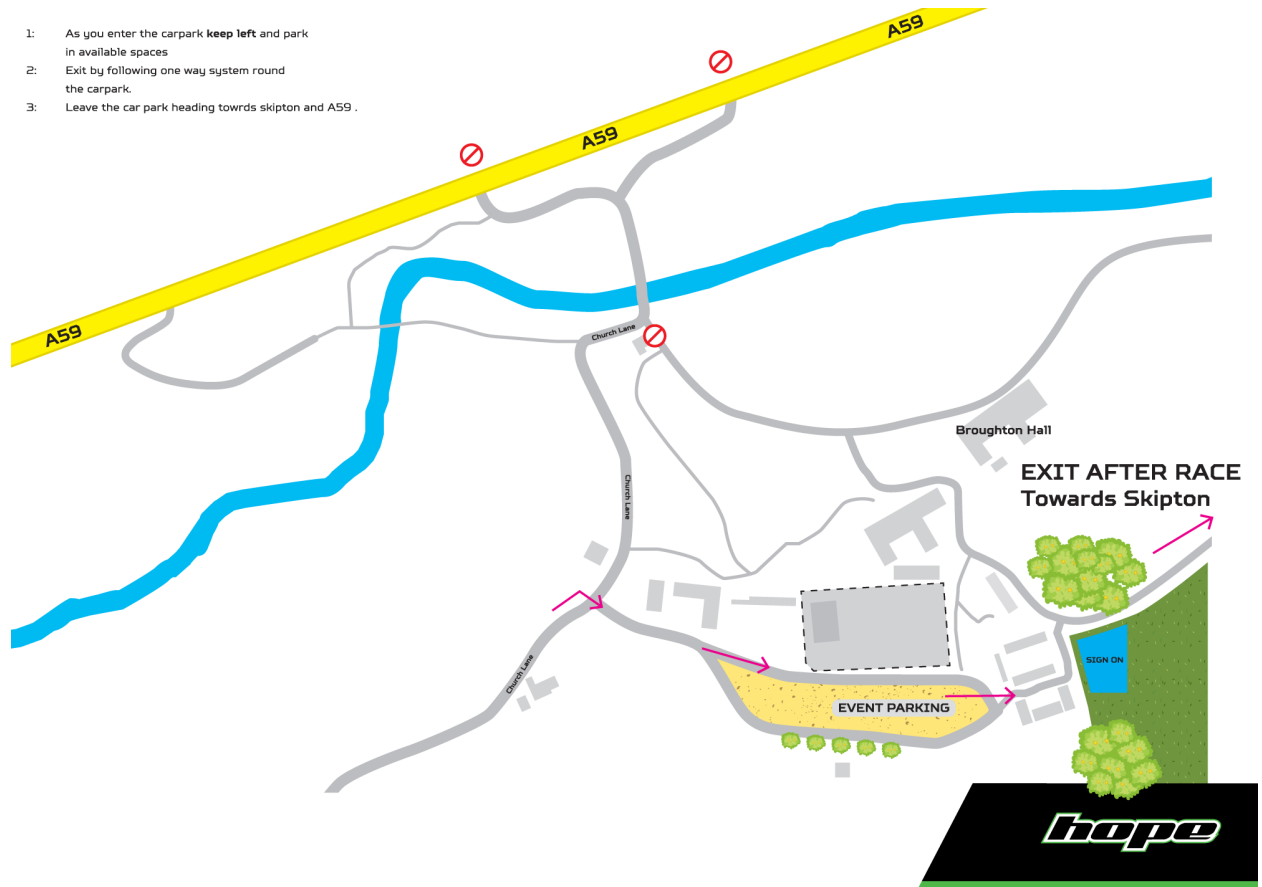
Entry is from the Elslack (Barnoldswick) road only, and to exit, vehicles must follow signs.
